CALL FOR LETTERS OF INTENT FOR RESEARCH GRANTS: AWARD YEAR 2020

The aim of the Program is to promote, through **international** cooperation, **basic** research focused on the elucidation of the sophisticated and **complex mechanisms of living organisms** for the benefit of all humankind. Applicants are expected to develop **novel** lines of research distinct from their ongoing research. HFSPO attaches the highest importance to novelty, scientific merit, internationality, and interdisciplinarity. Preliminary results are not required.

Program Grants are for independent scientists at all stages of their careers while **Young Investigators' Grants** are for teams of scientists who are **all** within 5 years of establishing an independent laboratory and within 10 years of obtaining their PhDs. Both provide 3 years support for 2 – 4 member teams, with not more than one member from any one country. Awards are dependent upon team size and successful teams will receive up to \$450,000 per year. The principal applicant must be located in one of the **HFSP** member countries but co-investigators may be located in any country.
