

INTRODUCTION

The ESC will provide funding to support an individual, group, institute or organisation with a project that has a scientific basis with a described relevant outcome(s) and is related to the aims of the ESC. Examples include: research into methods or provision of contraception, sexual and reproductive health; validated questionnaires to understand uptake or utilization of a method or procedure; or needs assessment within a community or locale. The money must be used for a definite project within a definite time period and with specified outcome measures. Applicants must be paid up ESC European members with their membership paid within a European country. However, a European applicant is allowed to submit a scientific project that will take place outside Europe.

All applications are marked by the Internal Scientific Committee which makes the final choice of winners from agreed criteria. The final list is ratified by the ESC Treasurer. There is no appeal against their decision.

APPLICATION

A maximum of 10,000 euro per scientific project application can be requested. The ESC may not be in a position to fully fund approved applications.
