


EASL Fellowship application process


Step 1:

Create your EASL Membership on the [EASL website](#) and by clicking on “Become a member” - If you already are a member, please enter your credentials and skip to Step 7




Step 2:







Choose your payment method and proceed to payment - Please note that you cannot apply to any Fellowship if your membership has not been paid




Step 7:




